- 2 Generally, the KIND OF PREACHING that is needed today is not the kind people want •••

Many want sermons that are \$MOOTH, EASY, and NOT TOO DIRECT ...

Isaiah 30:8-10 ... Now go, write it before them on a tablet, And note it on a scroll, That it may be for time to come, Forever and ever: 9 That this is a rebellious people, Lying children, Children who will not hear the law of the LORD; 10 Who say to the seers, "Do not see," And to the prophets, "Do not prophety to us right things; Speak to us smooth things, prophety deceits.

Others want a sermon that does not make them or others UNEASY ...

Jeremiah 5:30-31 ... "An astonishing and horrible thing Has been committed in the land: 31 The prophets prophesy falsely, And the priests rule by their own power; And My people love to have it so. But what will you do in the end?

Some think success is measured in **NUMBER\$**, but it is God who gives the **INCREA\$E** •••

I Corinthians 3:6-7 ... I planted, Apollos watered, but God gave the increase. 7 So then neither he who plants is anything, nor he who waters, but God who gives the increase.

Many focus attention on what **PLEASES THE CROWD**, but **PLEASING GOD** is what counts ...

I Thessalonians 2:4 ... But as we have been approved by God to be entrusted with the gospel, even so we speak, not as pleasing men, but God who tests our hearts.

Today many focus on **ENTERTAINMENT**, but the honest heart **SEEK\$ TRUTH ...**

Luke 8:15 ... "But the ones that fell on the good ground are those who, having heard the word with a noble and good heart, keep it and bear fruit with patience.

Christian's are to be the SALT of the EARTH Matthew 5:13 ... "You are the salt of the earth; but if the salt loses its flavor, how shall it be seasoned? It is then good for nothing but to be thrown out and trampled underfoot by men. Christians are taught not to shine their lights, but to let their LIGHT\$ \$HINE ... - Faithful in our ATTENDANCE, people see it! - Put Christ FIRST and SET OUR AFFECTIONS on things above! - LIVING PURE LIVES, that others may see the TRUTH ...

Matthew 5:14-16 ... "You are the light of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hidden. 15 "Nor do they light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a lampstand, and it gives light to all who are in the house. 16 "Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.

Jesus EXPOSED RELIGIOUS SECTS, so people could

understand and not be deceived •••

Matthew 5:20 ... "For I say to you, that unless your righteourness exceeds the righteourness of the scribes and Pharisees, you will by no means enter the kingdorn of heaven.

Lesus made it plain, that there was NO EXCUSE FOR **PERVERTING** the truth ...

Matthew 15:7-9 ... "Hypocrites! Well did Isaiah prophesy about you, saying: "These people draw near to Me with their mouth, And honor Me with their lips, But their heart is far from Me. And in vain they worship Me, Teaching as doctrines the commandments of men."

Jesus made it plain, WHO He was speaking about and WHAT the sin was •••

Matthew 23:29-33 ... "Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! Because you build the tombs of the prophets and adorn the monuments of the righteous, 30 "and say, "If we had lived in the days of our fathers, we would not have been partakers with them in the blood of the prophets." 31 "Therefore you are witnesses against yourselves that you are sons of those who murdered the prophets. 32 "Fill up, then, the measure of your fathers' guilt. 33 "Serpents, brood of vipers! How can you escape the condemnation of hell?

Phould Deal With Specific SINS

HATRED (This is what caused them to nail Jesus to the Cross) •••

Matthew 5:23-24 ... "Therefore if you bring your gift to the altar, and there remember that your brother has something against you, 24 "leave your gift there before the altar, and go your way. First be reconciled to your brother, and then come and offer your gift."

2 LUST (The immodest dress, language, and indecent entertainment all contribute to this) •••

Matthew 5:27-28 ... "You have heard that it was said to those of old, 'You shall not commit adultery.' 28 "But I say to you that whoever looks at a woman to lust for her has already committed adultery with her in his feart.

3 ADULTERY (It is getting so common today that many think it's lawful) •••

Matthew 5:31-32 ... "Furthermore it has been said, 'Whoever divorces his wife, let him give her a certificate of divorce.' 32 "But I say to you that whoever divorces his wife for any reason except sexual immorality causes her to commit adultery; and whoever marries a woman who is divorced commits adultery."

4 SWEARING (Breaking promises and using God's name in an irreverent way) •••

Matthew 5:33-37 ... "Again you have heard that it was said to those of old, "You shall not swear falsely, but shall perform your oaths to the Lord," But I say to you, do not swear at alls neither by heaven, for it is Coal's throne; 35 "hor by the earth, for it is His footstool; nor by Jerusalem, for it is the city of the great King. 36 "Nor shall you swear by your head, because you cannot make one hair white or black. 37 "But let your 'Yes' be 'Yes," and your 'No,' 'No.' For whatever is more than these is from the evil one."

5 VENGEANCE (This is something that Jesus did not do and neither should we) •••

Matthew 5:83-39 ... "You have heard that it was said, 'An eye for an eye and a tooth for a tooth.' 39 "But I tell you not to resist an evil person, But whoever slaps you on your right cheek, turn the other to him also."

6 HYPOCRISY (This is when you are not yourself, except on Sunday) ••••

Matthew 6:1 ... "Take heed that you do not do your charitable deeds before men, to be seen by them. Otherwise you have no reward from your Father in heaven."

Fould Deal With Specific SINS

FORGIVENESS (If we do not forgive others God will not forgive us) ••••

Matthew 6:14-15 ... For if you forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. 15 "But if you do not forgive men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.

MATERIALISM (There has never been a society where this threat has been greater) •••

matthew 6:24 ... "No one can serve two masters; for either he will hate the one and love the other, or else he will be loyal to the one and despise the other. You same serve God and mammon.

9 JUDGING (Doing what you condemn others for)

Matthew 7:1-5 ... "Judge not, that you be not judged. 2 "For with what judgment you judge, you will be judged; and with the measure you use, it will be measured back to you. 3 "And why do you look at the speck in your brother's eye, but do not consider the plank in your own eye? 4 "Or how can you say to your brother, 'Let me remove the speck from your eye; and look, a plank is in your own eye? 5 "Hypocrite! First remove the plank from your own eye, and then you will see clearly to remove the speck from your brother's eye.

That There is Only One Way to Heaven O Christians are taught that SALVATION lays on the STRAIT and NARROW WAY ... Matthew 7:13-14 pm Enter by the narrow gate; for wide is the gate

Matthew 7:13-14 ... "Enter by the narrow gate; for wide is the gate and broad is the way that leads to destruction, and there are many who go in by it, 14 "Because narrow is the gate and difficult is the way which leads to life, and there are few who find it."

- Jesus promised that He would build HIS CHURGH ... Matthew 16:18 ... "And I also say to you that you are Peter, and on this rock I will build My church, and the gates of Hades shall not prevail against it."
- B Paul taught that there was only ONE BODY and that it was the CHURCH ...

Ephesians 1:22-23 ... "And He put all things under His feet, and gave Him to be head over all things to the church, 23 which is His body, the fullness of Him who fills all in all."

Ephesians 434-5 ... "There is one body and one spirit, just as you were called in one hope of your calling; 5 one Lord, one faith, one baptism; 6 one God and Faither of all, who is above all, and through all, and in you all."

Ephesians 5:23 ... "For the husband is head of the wife, as also Christ is head of the church; and He is the Savior of the body."

HEAR

Romans 10:17 ... "So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God."

BELIEVE

John 8:24 ... "Therefore I said to you that you will die in your sins; for if you do not **believe** that I am He, you will die in your sins."

REPENT

Luke 13:3 ... "I tell you, no; but unless you repent you will all likewise perish."

CONFESS

Acts 8:37 ... "Then Philip said, "If you believe with all your heart, you may." And he answered and said, "I believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God."

BAPTISM

Acts 2:38 ... "Then Peter said to them, "Repent, and let every one of you be **baptized** in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit."

Christians are taught that they must be **OBEDIENT** to the FATHERS WILL ... Matthew 7:21-23 ... 
HEARING ONLY, but by HEARING and DOING ...
