

8 Prohibitive Commands

**Do not lie to one another, since you
have put off the old man with his
deeds,**

Colossians 3: 9

**If we live in the Spirit,
let us also walk in the Spirit. Let us
not become conceited, provoking
one another, envying one another.**

Galatians 5: 25-26

So then each of us shall give account of himself to God. Therefore let us not judge one another anymore, but rather resolve this, not to put a stumbling block or a cause to fall in our brother's way.

Romans 14: 12-13

**Do not speak evil of one another,
brethren. He who speaks evil of a
brother and judges his brother,
**speaks evil of the law and judges the
law. But if you judge the law, you are



Fervent means to:


Exhibit a particular enthusiasm, zeal, conviction, persistence, or belief.

Beloved, let us love one another, for love is of God; and everyone who loves **is born of God and knows God.**

1 John 4: 7

Beloved, if God so loved us, we also ought to love one another.

No one has seen God at any time. If we love one another, God abides in us, and His love has been perfected in us.

**so we, *being many*, are one body in
Christ, and individually members of
one another.**

**Be kindly affectionate to one another
with brotherly love, in honor giving
preference to one another;**

Be of the same mind toward one another. Do not set your mind on high things, but associate with the humble. Do not be wise in your own opinion.

**Owe no one anything except to love
one another, for he who loves
another has fulfilled the law.**

Romans 13: 8

... that you speak the same thing,
and *that* there be no divisions among
you, but *that* you be perfectly joined
together in the same mind and in the
same judgment.

For you, brethren, have been called to liberty; only do not *use* liberty as an opportunity for the flesh, but through love serve one another.

**Be hospitable to one another without
grumbling.**

Therefore, putting away lying, " *Let each one of you speak truth with his neighbor,*" **for we are members of one another.**

**And be kind to one another,
tenderhearted, forgiving one another,

bearing with one another, and
forgiving one another, if anyone has
a complaint against another; even as
Christ forgave you, so you also must
do.

Colossians 3: 13

Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom, teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord.

Colossians 3: 16

For all the law is fulfilled in one word,
*even in this: "You shall love your
neighbor as yourself."* But if you bite
and devour one another, beware lest
you be consumed by one another!

Galatians 5: 14-15

Confess your trespasses to one another, and pray for one another,
that you may be healed. The effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much.

James 5: 16

**And may the Lord make you increase and
abound in love to one another and to all,
just as we *do* to you,**

1 Thessalonians 3: 12

Finally, all of you be of one mind, having compassion for one another; love as brothers, *be tenderhearted, be courteous*; not returning evil for evil or reviling for reviling, but on the contrary *blessing*, knowing that you were called to this, that you may inherit a blessing.

1 Peter 3: 8-9
